The NCSE has informed this school that parents/guardians must notify them of any application being made to our school. This process is explained below in <u>'Parents Notify Details</u>.' Please complete the registration at NCSE to receive a letter of eligibility which you must then include with your application.

Applying for a place in St Oliver Plunkett School

Children are admitted to St Oliver Plunkett's based on the results of an educational psychological assessment. Applications may be submitted by the psychologist, the child's current school, or the parent/guardian on behalf of the child.

Enrolment is conducted strictly in accordance with our Admissions Policy. Please note that the number of applications we receive consistently exceeds the number of places available.

The child must

- Be aged between 8-12
- Have a specific reading difficulty
- Have average/above average intelligence

Enrolment is limited to a maximum of two years, full-time. The requirement for a second year will be assessed during the child's first year of attendance.

To qualify for placement at St Oliver Plunkett's, dyslexia must be identified as the child's primary learning difficulty.

To apply for a place, simply complete the **Application Form** and send it by email to **applications@stoliverplunkett.ie** along with a copy of the following documents::

- Your child's Educational Psychological Report
- Any other relevant professional reports such as; Speech and Language, Occupational Therapy etc
- Birth Certificate
- Letter of Eligibility, as directed by the NCSE (September 2025)
